## Parent & Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)



A highly effective and evidenced-based program backed by more than 30 years of research. Program is specialized in serving young children ages 2 – 6 and specifically addresses conduct, behavior and defiance issues by teaching parents skills to reduce conflict and associated stress. Interventions typically consist of weekly 1 hour sessions and can range from 10- 20 sessions based on each child and families' needs. Certified through PCIT International, staff works closely with the child and parent(s), guardians/caregivers via live coaching to improve behavior and compliance. Sessions are available in English & Spanish at our main ECD office located in Doral as well as at our Maternal and Child Health Center located in Hialeah. This County-Wide program providing services since 2010, provides screening follow up, individualized supports and early interventions to more than 1,500 children annually ages birth to 5, **participating in the School Readiness Program** and need developmental screening follow up and supports. Services include; screening follow up, individualized supports, consultation and referral assistance. The goal is to ensure children are identified early, receive the supports they need and are ready to learn upon entering kindergarten. \*A limited number of private (non SR) slots are also available.
